### COMPANIONSHIP AND DOMESTIC SUPPORT

**£25.00 per hour**

For a carer who offers social interaction consider 'Companionship and Domestic Support'. Support includes mental stimulation through engaging activities, including reading, conversation and time outdoors. The service user will also benefit from general domestic assistance, which covers housekeeping (i.e. cleaning, laundry and shopping), assistance in food preparation and mealtimes, and any help at home that might be required.

### COMPLEX CARE

**£29.00 per hour**

For an extensive level of support, encompassing dressing, bathing, toileting, hoisting, medication administration and more, consider 'Complex Care'. This option is suitable for anyone with more demanding care needs.

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- All types of dementia (vascular, Alzheimer's, Lewy body, etc), multiple sclerosis, stroke, Parkinson's, learning disabilities, diabetes, COPD, mental health, cerebral palsy, autism, mobility restriction (rheumatism, arthritis), etc.
- Personal care; bathing, showering, strip wash, changing pads, emptying catheter, changing colostomy bag or conveen, etc.
- Service user observation.
- Moving and handling tasks; hoist, turner, sliding sheet, bath lift, all types of transfers, fall prevention.
- Accompanying clients to appointments (bank, medical, social services and other activities).
- Companionship.
- Correspondence management (nominated carers only).
- Money handling/shopping /paying bills (nominated carers only).
- Meal preparation and service, special dietary requirements, peg feeding.
- Malnutrition management.
- Oxygen, nebuliser and gas cylinder management.
- Medication administration; tablets, ointments, patches, drop, etc.
- Reablement; rehabilitation tasks prepared individually, progress observation, care planning.
- Epilepsy management (observation reporting, dealing seizures, medication administration, emergency management).
- Learning disabilities service; physical exercises, manual activities, activity accompaniment, food management, personal care management, general support.
- Stroke management (communication, mobility, monitoring of swallowing related issues).
